IN STORE: FROM APRIL 18TH WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



FACE COVERINGS



- Customers in Wales are not required by law to wear a face covering while in the store.
- If customers choose to wear a face covering, you can still ask them to lower or remove it to ID them for age restricted products like alcohol.

OTHER MEASURES IN STORE

Retailers are no longer legally required to to undertake specific Covid-19 risk assessments and take reasonable measures to minimise transmission risks. Workplaces will still be subject to other legal responsibilities, such as under the Health and Safety at Work Act.


Retailers can still choose to take additional measures in store to reduce the risk of transmission of Covid-19, measures may include:

SELF ISOLATING



From 28th March, it is no longer a legal requirement to selfisolate if you test positive for Covid in Wales.

People who test positive and those with symptoms are still strongly advised to self-isolate, but it is no longer a legal requirement.
