

## IN STORE: FROM FEBRUARY 24 2022 WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

## FACE COVERINGS



- Customers and colleagues in England are no longer required to wear a face covering in stores
- You can have your own in-store policy to ask customers to wear a face covering to help stop the spread of Covid-19
- You can still ask customers to lower or remove a face covering to ID them for age restricted products like alcohol

## OTHER MEASURES IN STORE

There is no legal requirement to have additional measures in store to reduce the risk of spreading Covid-19, but you may want to keep some measures to help make customers and other colleagues feel more comfortable, such as:

## SELF ISOLATING



- There is no longer a legal obligation to self-isolate if you test positive for Covid-19
- The Public Health advice for people who test positive for Covid-19 is to stay at home to stop the spread of the virus
- Workers do not need to inform their employer if they have been advised to self isolate
